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2024 Hometown Hero Banner Program Guidelines

Mission - Honor and recognize City of Norwalk servicemen and servicewomen and their families who serve, have served or given their lives to our country in the United States Armed Forces.

Application Requirements

In order to be considered for a banner, the hero must meet the following requirements:

1. Resides or lived in the City of Norwalk at some point in their lifetime.

2. Currently serving or served in the United States Armed Forces.

3. Meet one of the following criteria: honorably discharged Veteran, died in the line of duty, current active duty. 4. May be required to provide proof of discharge verification.

Banner Design, Time Frame & Location

Banners are 24"x 48", double sided, vinyl material and include service person's name, branch of service and photograph. Banners will be displayed on light poles along the Uptown District for a period of time as determined by the Mayor. Banner locations will be selected randomly, and specific display locations cannot be requested.

Banner Photograph

Applicant must supply the photograph to be used on the banner. A printed photograph or an electronic image of high quality will be accepted. If you want your photograph returned you will need to put your name and address on the back of the photo, and it will be mailed back to you. Note: An 8X10 photo is preferred but wallet size is acceptable.

Banner Pricing

A fee of \$84.00 must be submitted with the completed application. Pricing includes the production of the banner, shipping, taxes and fees. The hardware to hang the banner will be provided. Applications will be on a first come first serve basis. If purple heart recipient/ gold star family and its a new banner there will be no extra fee for the added decal as it will be printed on the banner.

Payments Accepted: Cash, Personal Check, Money Order or Cashiers Check. Credit/Debit Cards will be accepted, a 3% fee will be added to all debit/credit cards. (credit card payments will only be accepted at the Norwalk Area Visitor's Bureau)

(City Hall's drop box may also be used to drop off the application and fee.) The application and fee can also be dropped at the Huron County Chamber of Commerce, 10 W. Main Street, Norwalk.

Other Information

The City will store the banners when they are not in use. Banners will be hung up for Armed Forces Day, May 18, 2024 through Veteran's Day, November 11, 2024. Unclaimed banners will become property of the City. The City of Norwalk General Services Department will erect the banners and remove the banners at the Mayor's discretion. The banner may be moved or relocated to accommodate other City events but will be rehung after the event is over. Family members may request that their banner be returned to them once the City removes the banners from the poles if they do not want them to be displayed any longer. Prior arrangements can be made by calling Norwalk City Hall. NO ONE IS PERMITTED TO INSTALL OR REMOVE THEIR OWN BANNERS.
